First Uganda 'Miracle' Donation

Fr. Henry, 4 years ordained, drove me around while I was in Uganda. At the end of our time together, he had just received a letter from his bishop appointing him to be the first pastor of a new parish. I went to see his new place which has *a lot* of needs—like all parishes there. I asked him to send me a dollar figure for some needs. He sent me info on 3 projects costing \$28,000. The next day I received an email from a parishioner I did not know. She had read our bulletin on Uganda the week before. This parishioner, who prefers to remain anonymous, said she wanted to donate \$28,000 to Fr. Henry's new parish. When I met with this lovely lady and asked her what moved her to such generosity, she said she was prompted by the Holy Spirit. She also said she reads my Morning Prayer each day. One line in the prayer speaks about "hearing and responding to the promptings of the Holy Spirit." I am praying that the Holy Spirit will lead many of you to help our brothers and sisters in a faraway place.
